3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Gold Star Family Tax
5	Relief Act".
6	SEC. 2. CERTAIN MILITARY SURVIVOR BENEFITS TREATED
7	AS EARNED INCOME FOR KIDDIE TAX.
8	(a) In General.—Section 1(g)(4) of the Internal

Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end

10 the following new subparagraph:

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1	"(D) Treatment of certain military
2	SURVIVOR BENEFITS.—For purposes of this
3	subsection, any benefit under laws administered
4	by the Secretary of Defense or the Secretary of
5	Veterans Affairs which—
6	"(i) is received by a child by reason of
7	the child being the survivor of a deceased
8	member of the Armed Forces or of a de-
9	ceased veteran, and
10	"(ii) is included in the gross income of
11	such child,
12	shall be considered earned income of such
13	child.".
14	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
15	this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
16	December 31, 2017.
