

FIGHTING FOR FUNDING



Senator Tester introduced his bipartisan **ANTI Drugs Act** to increase funding for COPS, HIDTA, and Operation Stonegarden. He'll keep pushing for more resources for these programs, Byrne JAG, and federal law enforcement programs **to help with staffing, paying for equipment, and to support border security operations.**

RECRUITING AND RETAINING OFFICERS

Senator Tester's **Recruit and Retain Act** will boost hiring in understaffed departments across the Treasure State by creating a schools-to-law enforcement career pipeline, make it easier for understaffed agencies to **access federal funding** to hire officers, and improve law enforcement retention.

SUPPORT THE POLICE

COMBATTING DRUG TRAFFICKING

Senator Tester recently had three bipartisan bills signed into law to combat fentanyl. His **Protecting America's Borders Against Fentanyl Act** requires DHS to develop additional technologies to detect illicit fentanyl, his

PREVENT Act requires DHS to provide drug containment devices to our frontline officers, and his **FEND Off Fentanyl Act** targets the international trafficking of fentanyl at its source.



BOOSTING SMALLER AGENCIES

Senator Tester's **Invest to Protect Act** would create a new Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) grant program with a streamlined application process for local and Tribal law enforcement agencies with **under 200 sworn officers**. Grants can be used for needs like training, equipment, mental health support, and recruitment.
